I am writing in to you to thank two of your students for their assistance.

I am a resident of Blk 207 Tampines St. 21. On 16 May 2011 (Mon), around 4.40pm, I was trapped on the ground floor of Lift C. The doors of the lift were opened with a tiny gap. I tried to open but in vain. I pressed the alarm but no one came to my rescue, with some adults and children passing by without looking at the lift.

Just when I was feeling panicky, as I was going to be late for my appointment, one of your student (perhaps primary 4-6) happened to pass by and responded to my call of help. I signalled him to give me the contact number of the lift maintenance which was listed outside the lift, but instead he told me to wait and went to call his classmate, a small skinny boy with spectacles. This boy told me - "Aunty, don't worry, we will help you." Both of them used their full force to open the doors for me.

I am very grateful for what these 2 boys had done. The fact that there were some adults/housewives sitting at the void deck, which is very near to the lift and yet they ignored my commotion for help. These 2 boys were brave and they proceeded with the rescue without the help of the elders.

So, I think these 2 students should be commended for their positive and helpful attitudes. They can be the role model for the other students to follow. Though I do not know their names and where they stay, I think I should inform the school for having these 2 outstanding students.
