

# e-Learning @ CZPS

E-learning is a critical part of Chongzheng's teaching and learning curriculum each year. You child will be able to engage in both collaborative and self-directed learning through our main e-learning portal ([www.mconline.sg](http://www.mconline.sg)) as well as our other portals such as iMTL, e-Oralcly portals.

[www.mconline.sg](http://www.mconline.sg) also enables you child to access other useful platforms such as Mindomo for mind mapping, Google Docs for collaborative word processing and presentation, and email which is the main mode of online communication between teachers and students for Home-Based Learning and during school closures.
